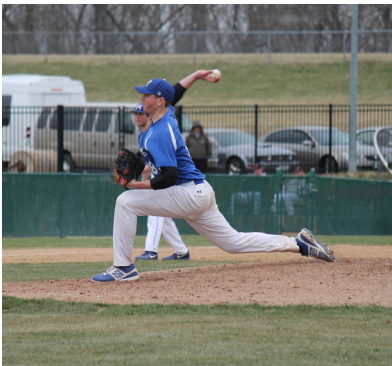

Entering the Series

Rockhurst 11-9 Overall, 4-4 GLVC

The Hawks enter the weekend series coming off a 13-2 loss to MIAA opponent Missouri Western. Rockhurst had twenty-six players participate in the game and seven were pitchers sent to the mound to get work in.

Last weekend, the Hawks traveled to Kenosha, Wis., where they took on GLVC rival UW-Parkside. They were able to sweep the Rangers in day one action, but could not get any offense going in day two in 35 degree weather. Sophomore shortstop Brett Marr and Caleb Baker led Rockhurst going 6-14 and 6-15 respectively. Both players led the team in batting average and are hitting above .400 on the season.

Right handed pitchers Joe Huber and Michael Lydon-Lorson both earned wins against the Rangers. Huber was able to go the distance and recorded his fourth complete game win. He gave up nine hits, but was able to bear down with runners in scoring position to hold UW-Parkside to three runs winning the ball game 5-3. Huber struck out seven and walked two on the day.

Lydon-Lorson earned his fourth win on the season in a close game for the Hawks. He went 5.2 innings, giving up five runs on six hits, striking out four and walking three. Rockhurst won game two 7-5.

Quincy 11-6 Overall, 7-1 GLVC

The Hawks enter the weekend series coming off a 4-3 extra inning loss to MIAA opponent Northwest Missouri. Quincy out-hit and out-fielded the Bearcats recording one more hit and one error while Northwest committed three.

Last weekend, the Hawks hosted GLVC rival Belarmino and swept all four games with scores of 4-1, 2-1, 4-0, and 10-6. Sophomore utility player David Jacob and redshirt sophomore pitcher Mark Niebrugge led Quincy as both players earned GLVC honors. Niebrugge was named Pitcher of the Week while Jacob was named Player of the Week.

Getting to know Shortstop Brett Marr

I got a chance to sit down with Brett Marr and pick his mind. Here is some of his thoughts on the 2014 season, 2015 season so far and the future to come.



What drove your decision to come to Rockhurst?

Marr: The past success of Rockhurst baseball really interested me in coming here and the fact that Coach Burns told me that he has only had six shortstops for him in all of his years at Rockhurst. Becoming the seventh made Rockhurst seem like a good fit for me and I was excited for the opportunity.

Since you entered Rockhurst your freshman year, you have started every single game for the Hawks (64). Is that something you take pride in?

Marr: Definitely, I love playing baseball and when looking for a college I wanted a place where I could play everyday and be a four-year starter because that is what would make the experience the most enjoyable for me.

Were there any

times you played through an injury?

Marr: Yes, last year against Drury I got hit in the elbow and it swelled up pretty good limiting movement. I put a compression sleeve on the elbow and bought an Evoshield elbow guard and was good to go.

You had a very successful freshman season batting .308 scoring 26 runs and collecting 25 RBI. What did you take away from your freshman

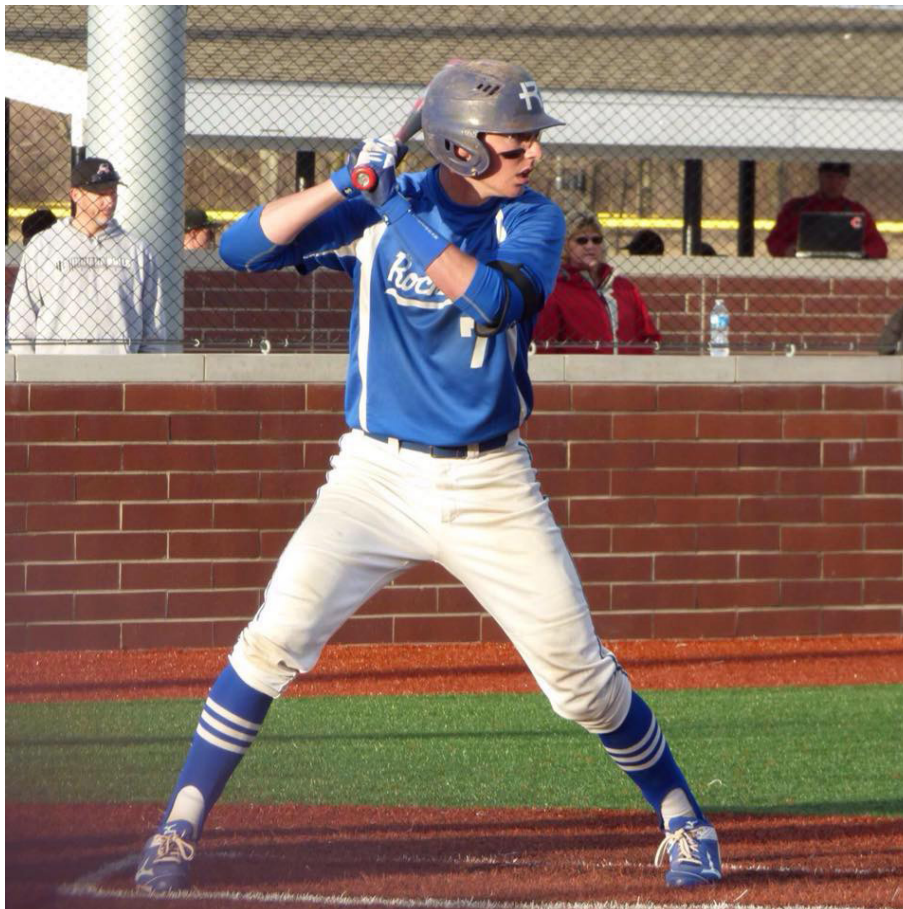
year?

Marr: First of all, the toll a college season takes on the body and mentally as compared to seasons before. So I had to learn how to recover and take care of myself in between games. Second, the speed of the game picks up a lot in college and playing at this new level and speed

has made the game more fun. It has created even more of a passion for me.

After Rockhurst's down 2014 year, the Hawks are 11-6 overall and have a 4-2 GLVC record. What are the expectations as we continue forward through the 2015 campaign?

Marr: The team goals for this year are to finish above .500 and return to the conference tournament, and then hopefully make some noise

up in Indianapolis. We need to build off the momentum from this start and carry it over into GLVC play as each conference game means so much and all teams are real competitive.

You're currently hitting .500 on the year and had one of Rockhurst best series performances ever going 12-for-17 with six RBI. What do you attribute your success to?

Marr: A lot of hard work and a little bit of luck. This summer I got to face the best pitchers I have ever faced on an every night basis in the Prospect League. This really helped me as a hitter, technique-wise, and from a mental approach. Additionally, I spent a lot of time in the cage this winter and received some little tips that made the difference.

What was the most important thing to you throughout the offseason and summer?

Marr: This summer taught me how to be mentally ready night in and night out and to elevate my game to the next level. One of the most important aspects is to continue to slow the game down as the pace speeds up. Playing in Hannibal really provided a minor league experience playing at least six days a week. It was a physical and mental grind at times, but I learned from it and it will help me during the

Marr: Be nice to your glove and it'll be nice to you, ha ha. But by scouting the opponents before the game, I have a general idea of tendencies

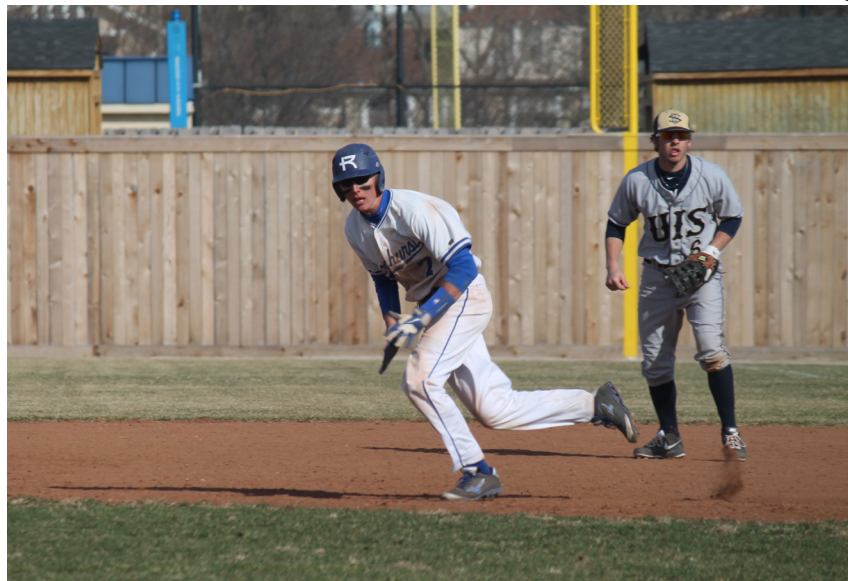
exactly the approach I take when I play.

What are your goals for college baseball and beyond?

Marr: For college I came here with full belief and still believe that we will win a GLVC conference title and be very competitive in a regional. A trip to Cary, N.C., would be an amazing way to top it all off. I still dream about playing in the Major Leagues and I am definitely working for that and becoming the best player I can be.

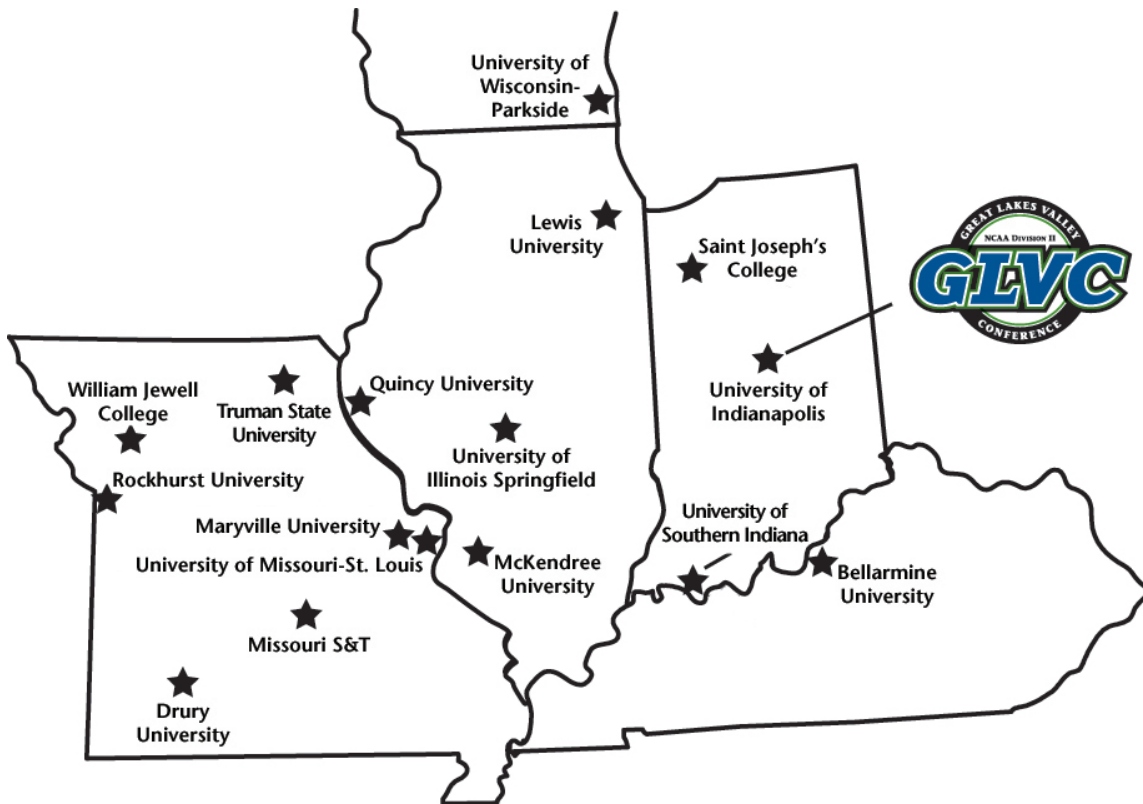
